In 2018 she was appointed SVP of Consolidated Planning and Control at Eni and subsequently in 2019 she was appointed SVP of Scenarios, Positioning and Medium-Long Term Plans while simultaneously holding the positions of Secretary of the Sustainability and Scenarios Committee and Secretary of the Evaluation Committee for Medium-Long Term Plans.
