Born in Genoa on February 8, 1964. He holds a degree in Industrial Technology Engineering with an organizational-economic specialization from the Milan Polytechnic

In 1990 he was hired by Snamprogetti in the Projects Management as Project Engineer, in charge of the technical-managerial coordination of the projects, initially located in India to follow the construction of a fertilizer plant in the Rajstan region and later in Qatar for the construction of a polyethylene plant. In 1996, upon his return from Qatar, he dealt with commercial offers, including an offer for an ethylene plant for Adnoc-Borealis. In 1997 he was appointed as Project Manager of a Gas Processing Plant built in Malaysia for Petronas.

In 1999 he left Snamprogetti and joined Technip France as Project Manager responsible for the FEED of an offshore upstream development for Agip Gas in Libya, after which he was appointed as Proposal Manager to follow the preparation of commercial offers including FPSO offers in Brazil for Petrobras and offshore upstream development projects in Iran for Shell.

In 2001 he left Technip and joined Edison, Oil and Gas Division, as Project Director of the Edison-British Gas (ELNG) JV for the development of Egyptian assets and the construction of the Rosetta LNG plant in Egypt.

Following the disposal of the Egyptian assets by Edison, in 2004 he left Edison and joined Eni, where for 5 years in Egypt he worked as Project General Manager in Petrobel in charge of the Egyptian upstream developments of Eni and subsequently of the FEED for the train 2 of the Damietta LNG plant.

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From 2009 to 2011 in Kazakhstan he held the position of Project Director of the Kashagan Offshore Experimental Program.

From 2011 to 2014 in Nigeria he took up the position of VP LNG and was responsible for coordinating Eni's LNG initiatives in Africa including the presanctioning activities of Brass LNG in Nigeria, during which he held the position of director of the NLNG board

From 2014 to 2019 based in the UK he assumed the role of VP LNG Operation of the Mozambique Program, contributing to the sanctioning and implementation of the Coral FLNG project with the preparation of the operational phase, support for the definition of project financing, support for technical commercial negotiation with the LNG buyer, agreements with partners and stakeholder management.

In 2019 he joined Saipem as Project Director of the Tangguh LNG project for BP. The same year he assumed responsibility for the operations of the APAC area of Saipem's onshore division, following, in addition to the Tangguh LNG project, also the construction of a regassification plant and a refinery in Thailand.

In January 2022 he assumed the position of Director of Operations until the recent appointment as COO of Energy Carriers.

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
