1957

OUR BEGINNINGS

We were born from the **union of the drilling contractor SAIP and the construction company Snam Montaggi** as a service provider for Eni, the Italian oil and gas giant, with a clear goal: contributing to transforming Italy from a mostly rural nation into a global industrial power. It is the start of a journey that immediately places us in front of complex projects where organisation, execution capability and accountability become our signature.



1950s-1960s

THE RISE OF A GLOBAL PLAYER

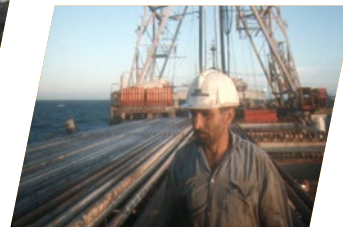
We established our international reputation in the **onshore drilling and pipeline laying markets**. With the **Scarabeo drilling rig** and the **pipelaying vessel Castoro 1**, we entered the offshore sector, launching operations in complex marine environments. It is a defining move: offshore becomes one of the industry's most demanding frontiers, and we position ourselves early among the pioneers capable of working where conditions are toughest.



1962

UREA TECHNOLOGY PATENT

We patented our **technology for urea production, Snamprogetti™ Urea**, marking an early shift from execution to proprietary industrial innovation. This is significant because it shows **our ecosystem can generate know-how**, not just apply it, strengthening competitiveness in a sector where process technologies can redefine markets and scale.



1970s

TURNING CRISIS INTO CAPABILITY

Amid global turbulence and the oil crisis, **we expanded into the North Sea** and strengthened expertise in harsh conditions. By operating in one of the most challenging basins of the time, we transformed external pressure into **higher standards of safety, reliability and performance**, capabilities that soon became industry benchmarks.



1980s

RAISING PROFILE THROUGH NEW RECORDS AND PUBLIC LISTING

The Transmed project sets a deep-water pipelaying record, reinforcing our role in strategic energy infrastructure. Beyond the milestone itself, it proves we can deliver **cross-border systems at unprecedented depth**, helping extend the reach of **gas transportation** and enabling new routes for **energy security**. In parallel, **our stock market listing** strengthened our standing and positioned us as an international benchmark player.



1990s

A SCALE UP IN OFFSHORE ENGINEERING

We acquired Sonsub and, in the late '90s, began designing and producing our ROVs, paving the way for our Hydron platform. With **Sonsub's subsea drones, Saipem 7000, and J-lay installation**, we reached exceptional lifting capacities and extended operations to new depths. This combination was a step change for the sector: heavier structures, deeper fields and more complex installations became feasible and **we consolidated a reputation for executing "impossible" offshore scopes**.

2001-2002

AN OFFSHORE GLOBAL CHAMPION

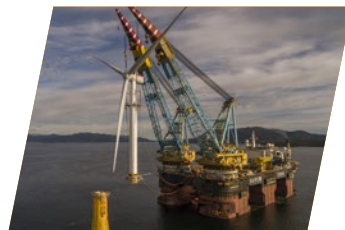
Through **Moss Maritime** and **Bouygues Offshore**, we expanded **our LNG and offshore capabilities**, broadening our portfolio to a wider range of high-value projects. We also strengthened our ability to compete across integrated engineering and delivery models, positioning ourselves as a leading offshore global champion.



2006

AN INCREASINGLY INTEGRATED BUSINESS MODEL

With the **acquisition of Snamprogetti**, we entered new strategic markets, including downstream and gas liquefaction, broadening our capabilities and delivery capacity. This was a key step that reinforced our offering in an industrial landscape increasingly oriented towards integrated operators, capable of **managing complex projects, interfaces and risk on a large scale**. In the same year, we published our first **Sustainability Report**.



2010s

NEW ENERGY MARKETS AND INNOVATION

In a context of growing environmental awareness, Eni's reduction of its stake in Saipem accelerated the company's transformation, driving the expansion into new activities, from decommissioning to renewables, including our **entry into offshore wind with Hywind, the world's first floating wind farm**, with digitalisation and innovation becoming integral to our industrial model.



2016

STRENGTHENING THE BUSINESS AND SUSTAINABILITY COMMITMENT

We enhanced our global positioning, contributing to major infrastructure projects such as Etihad Rail (Stage 1), **the first railway in the United Arab Emirates**. At the same time, by **joining the United Nations Global Compact**, we aligned our strategies with its ten principles on **human rights, labour, environmental protection and anticorruption**, reinforcing sustainability and corporate responsibility into our culture.



2020s

WE FOSTER INNOVATION THROUGH INGENUITY

Through proprietary technology development and strategic agreements, we accelerated the advancement of **energy transition solutions across CCUS, hydrogen and low-carbon technologies, for both large-scale plants and modular configurations**. At the same time, we continued to evolve conventional oil & gas through automation and asset digitalisation, enhancing the **safety, reliability and sustainability of operations**. We also strengthened subsea robotics, reinforcing our role as an innovator in offshore operations.

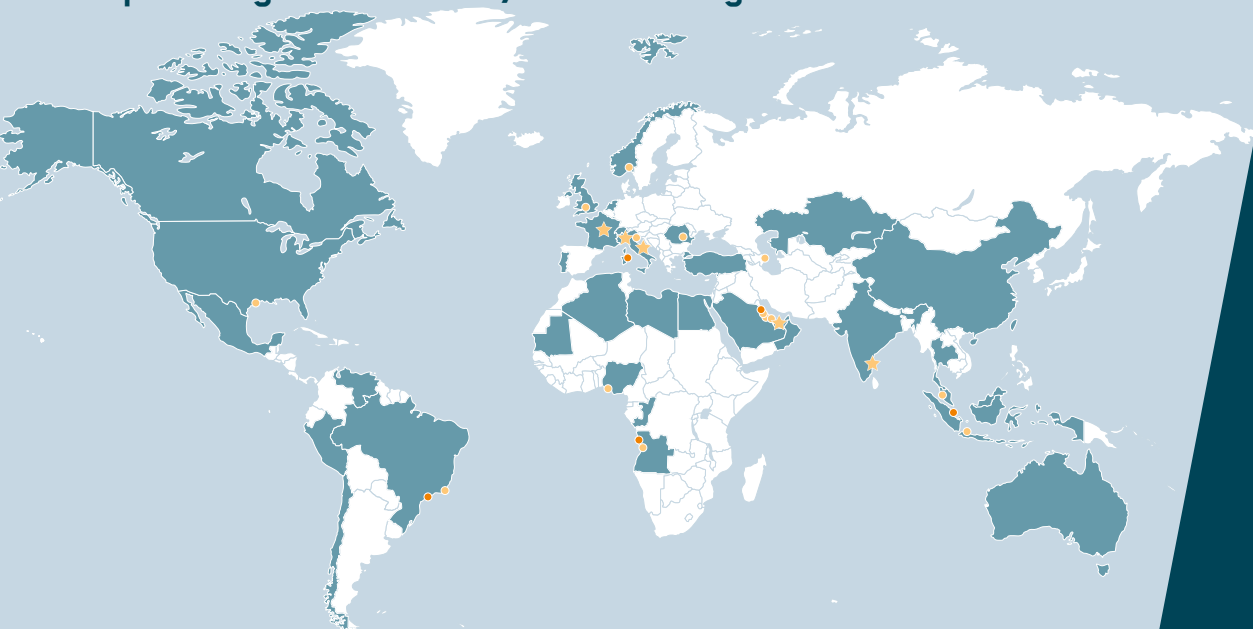

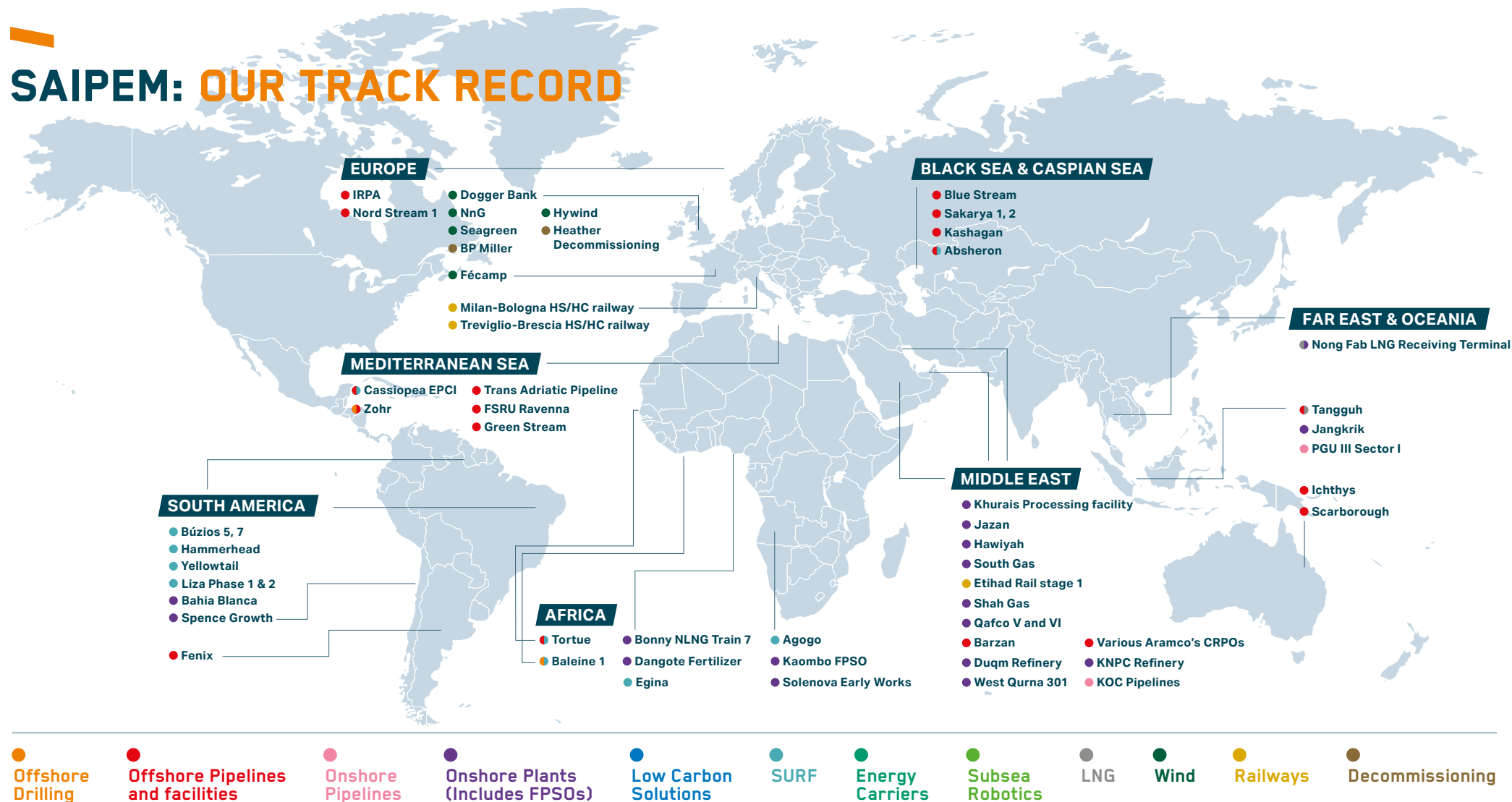

Key topics

01. ENVIRONMENT

We reduce our footprint by integrating sustainability across sites and operations and promoting innovation, circularity, and nature-based solutions for climate goals.

We are well on the path towards achieving our commitment to Net Zero by 2050, halving our Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions by 2035, while working with our suppliers to reduce Scope 3 emissions.

02. HEALTH & SAFETY

At Saipem, we are committed to achieving significant results while always safeguarding the health, safety, and well-being - both physical and mental - of our people.

We work to eliminate serious and fatal accidents by applying the principles of Human Performance, adopting advanced technologies, and ensuring the integrity of our assets.

To promote health and safety values in industry and society, in 2010, we established the LHS Foundation, a nonprofit organisation that develops initiatives based on high-impact emotional communication and the sharing of tools designed to strengthen leadership in safety.

03. INNOVATION

We drive innovation by enhancing competitiveness in our traditional business and to advance the energy transition with €61 million spent on innovation overall and €36 million in R&D expenditure.

We focus in particular on pipeline technologies, subsea robotics, CCUS, renewables and circular economy. We held 2,237 patents at the end of 2025, when we filed 27 new patent applications. Our ingenuity fuels competitiveness, sustainability and long-term value.

04. PEOPLE

Our people make the difference. We invest in training, inclusion and wellbeing, promoting equal opportunities and supporting every stage of life through programs for development, parenting, health and work-life balance.

In 2025, we provided more than 1 million hours of training and we invested €2 million in local community initiatives, implementing 71 activities in 20 countries.

In addition, we confirmed the maintenance of our UNI/PdR 125:2022 and ISO 30415:2024 certifications on Diversity & Inclusion, reinforcing our commitment to gender equality.
